



We are just a few days away from this year's Genoa Homecoming Parade! Here are a few FAQs to help you get ready for this year's event. The theme this year is "Comets in the Cosmos."

- **When is the Homecoming Parade?**

Friday, May 31st at 6:30pm – please come early and get your spot!

- **When will Main Street (and impacted side streets) be shut down?**

5:30pm until the parade is complete

- **What is the parade route?**

The parade begins at the corner of 12<sup>th</sup> and Main Street continues down Main to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, turns left onto 5<sup>th</sup> then left onto Washington Street. The parade ends at Veteran's Park.

- **Where can I park for the parade?**

Anywhere but St John's Church –

Veteran's Park

Around the Brunner Complex

West Street

Flourish Flat lot (corner of 17<sup>th</sup> and Main)

Trinity United Methodist Church

- **What should I do after the parade?**

March over to Veteran's Park for the Homecoming Festival!

St John's Church – there will be no parking at the church
